I created QAPLus Advanced Diagnostics, sold over 30M copies of QAPLus Diagnostics, and basically created the PC Diagnostics industry. Because "someone has to test all these PC's".

And with a little help from my friends at Intel (Intel owned 35% of DiagSoft).

QAPLus became one of the very first "Virus Detected" tools.

DiagSoft's QAPLus/Factory became defacto PC industry standard with over 85% Global Market share. QAPLus/Factory was focused on assisting the achievement of ISO 9000 Certification, and it

is estimated that over 100M PC's! were tested receiving a QAPLus Certified.

I opened Pac Rim HQ in the Maui MRTC, and created ETSC Electronic Tech Support Centers using QAPLus and Remote Anywhere, CloseUp, and other remote control software.

ETSC reduced the call time for a Tech Support Call, because the Tech knew what was in the PC, if it was working, and how it is configured. "Hit a button, get a beer simplicity". Sold DiagSoft to Sykes, Inc. Aug. 1996.

GKE published Condor rDBMS, and did custom apps for BusinessLand, and Consultant to Enzo Torressi of BusinessLand and David Norman. I sold more Condor than Condor, and closed MicroD, MicroAge, etc.

sold GKE to Condor Computer Corporation, deal went south, got a call from David Wertzberger (DEC, Handle) and was asked, Gordon you like boating? Lake Tahoe? want to go boating on Tahoe?, want to live there? Duh...

National Sales Manager at Artelonics, Inc.

Artelonics (Artel), Inc. was founded by Bill O'Dell and his wife, and actually developed the first 8086 PC with a lot of funding from Shell Oil Canada, Ltd. Frank Buckley was VP of Marketing and Sales, he was tough, like Bogard... I loved working for him, even though he often told me he could replace me at any moment...

Bob Stillman (Award) was VP Software, we developed a XEROX PARC competitive PC, but it was HUGH...

Shell decided to not be in the Office Automation market and erased the company.

Promoted from Mgr. Software Development to Director Advanced Systems.

Microform Data Systems was headed by my mentor Dean Mack.

I created CARMS, Computer Assisted Records Management System based on TANDEM NON-STOP computers and the data contained in Microform Ultra Strip Micrographics Viewers. Any page in 12M pages could be displayed in less than 10 seconds... Developed CARMS for Power Plant Document Storage and Retrieval. Advanced Workstation developments.
