I sold DiagSoft in Aug. 96 to Sykes, Inc. after much discussion with all DiagSoft employees, all of us were excited ...

The employees expected to have a job in a large secure company, and the top execs all got employment contracts with Sykes.

Big Kahuna Productions and MAST, Inc. were on the books of DiagSoft and could not be used for the future because of Sykes due diligence, and the pooling of interest of our books as a result of the merger. No ESOP had been completed. All 100% of DiagSoft's stock was in my name.

I had expected to continue with MAST and Big Kahuna since they were supposed to be separate, but Ed did not do it that way. Big Kahuna Productions was a dba.
